1. Updates to our Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy (“**Privacy Policy**”) is updated periodically; each time we make a change, we will post it on our website www.fundatia-vodafone.ro and will inform you accordingly.

2. Applicability

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use and otherwise process your personal data in the course of our business, when you work with us in whatever role, participate in our campaigns or are a beneficiary thereof.

This Privacy Policy is aimed at and addressed to the following categories of persons:

a) Donors, volunteers and other partners of the Vodafone Romania Foundation

This category refers to Vodafone Foundation partners who:

- support in their own name as donors, volunteers or jurors the work of the Foundation through involvement in its campaigns – e.g. Letters to Santa campaign, Platform for Good Deeds as well as to members of the Foundation's Board of Directors;
- are the representatives of contractual partners with whom the Vodafone Foundation has had or continues to have a contractual relationship for the implementation of its activities and campaigns - e.g. representatives and contact persons from associations and foundations that collaborate with the Vodafone Foundation, representatives and contact persons from suppliers that provide various services or from whom the Vodafone Foundation has purchased various goods or services.

b) Beneficiaries of the Vodafone Romania Foundation campaigns:

This category refers to individuals (adults and minors) who benefit from the services and products resulting from the campaigns that the Vodafone Foundation carries out as part of its activity – e.g. beneficiaries of projects funded by the Vodafone Foundation, beneficiaries of individual donation campaigns, beneficiaries of the Letters to Santa campaign, etc..

c) Candidates and employees of the Vodafone Romania Foundation

This category refers to individuals applying for a job with the Vodafone Foundation as well as individuals with whom the Vodafone Foundation has or has had an individual employment relationship.

3. Who we are?

We are **Vodafone Romania Foundation**. We are part of the Vodafone Group.

In this Privacy Policy:

- “**Vodafone Foundation/we**” means **Vodafone Romania Foundation**;
- “**Vodafone-controlled companies**” means any company in which Vodafone Romania S.A. has, directly or indirectly, the power to control or to determine the control of the management and policies, by holding voting rights, contractually or otherwise;
- “**Vodafone Group**” means Vodafone Group Plc and any company or other organisation in which Vodafone Group Plc owns more than 15% of the share capital, directly or indirectly;
- “**third party**” means a person other than you, us or an entity that processes personal data on our behalf;
- “**personal data**” means personal data as defined in the relevant European and national legislation and is information about an identifiable individual, whether or not linked to other information. Common examples of personal data processed by the Vodafone Foundation during day-to-day operations include names, addresses, telephone numbers and other contact details.

5. Our principles

The Vodafone Group, and therefore we, are committed to respecting your privacy. We take privacy, security and compliance with data protection legislation seriously. Our aim is to ensure that these commitments underpin everything we do.

6. Basics

6.1. What personal data we process?

The categories of personal data that we process differ depending on your relationship with us as well as how you interact or have interacted with the Vodafone Foundation. Below is a general list of these categories, noting that the applicable lists for each category of persons interacting with the Vodafone Foundation is detailed in the following sections:

- Identification data**, for example: your name, surname, address, copy of your identity document and signature; or
- Contact details**, e.g. your telephone and/or mobile number, and your e-mail or home address, if applicable;
- Financial data**, e.g. your income, information about your bank account;
- Data on qualifications**, e.g. education, profession or occupation, CV and professional experience;
- Data collected by cookies and similar technologies**. For details please visit the cookie policy at: <https://fundatia-vodafone.ro/politica-de-utilizare-a-cookie-urilor/>
- Authentication data** – passwords, hints and similar security information used for authentication and access to platforms applicable to Vodafone Foundation campaigns;
- Health data** – i.e. data from medical certificates attesting to the type and degree of your disability required for you to be involved in and benefit from Vodafone Foundation campaigns or data required for your employment with the Foundation.

6.2. Where we get your data from?

We will collect your personal data:

- Directly from you**, i.e. when you communicate information to us directly (e.g. by filling in a form) or through your interaction with our representatives.

For example, we will obtain your personal information when: (i) you apply to judge a Vodafone Foundation campaign, (ii) you apply to benefit from our programmes, (iii) you apply for a position with Vodafone, or (iv) contact us through various channels, or request information about Vodafone Foundation campaigns and events.

When we receive data directly from you we will assume that it is true, accurate, complete and that it belongs to you or, where applicable, you have the right to use it. We will make every effort to ensure that the data is true, accurate and that it belongs to you, and if there is any suspicion that you are submitting incorrect or incomplete data to us, or that you are using someone else's data without authorisation, we will take steps to rectify or stop this. For example, measures may consist of: update, complete or delete data, limit access to data used unlawfully – including deleting accounts associated with data that does not belong to you.

We will also consider the data collected directly from you to be current as long as you have not requested changes through the communication channels mentioned in paragraph 4 of the Privacy Policy or personally updated the data.

- Sources other than yourself**, i.e. data obtained from external sources.

External sources from which we may obtain your data include:

- **Public sources**, e.g. websites or social media pages, public databases (including Commercial Registry database, Ministry of Finance database, Official Gazette, court portals, etc.);
- **Third party private entities**, for example, (i) Vodafone partners (associations and foundations or other entities in which you are registered as a volunteer, beneficiary or where you are employed), (ii) our suppliers or contractors (including suppliers of goods or services);
- **Vodafone Group companies** (including entities acquired or controlled by us or the Vodafone Group);
- **Public authorities or institutions**, e.g. in the context of judicial investigations, court requests (in which case they may disclose

certain information about you).

7. If you are a donor, volunteer or other partner of the Vodafone Foundation

We will process the following personal data:

- a) **Identifying Data** – your name, surname, and depending on the activity you will carry out we may also process information on your address, copy of your identity document and your signature as appropriate;
- b) **Contact details** – your telephone and/or mobile number, and your e-mail address, if applicable;
- c) **Data collected by cookies and similar technologies** related to the web platforms managed by the Vodafone Foundation that you visit. For details please visit the cookie policy at: <https://fundatia-vodafone.ro/politica-de-utilizare-a-cookie-urilor/>
- d) **Authentication Data** – passwords, hints and similar security information used for authentication and access to the platforms applicable to the Vodafone Foundation campaigns that you will use;
- e) **Your image** – photos, video footage as appropriate;
- f) **Data on your professional experience** – i.e. data from your CV or other qualifications, only to the extent that you will carry out an activity supported by or for the Vodafone Foundation (e.g. you will be a member of the Board of Directors).

We will use your personal data for the following purposes:

7.1. Eligibility checks

Prior to your involvement in the Vodafone Foundation project and depending on the specifics of the activity to be carried out, we may carry out certain checks to determine whether you are eligible for involvement in that activity, as follows:

- in the case of volunteers or partners who will be involved in projects run by the Vodafone Foundation, it may be necessary to check your CV to verify that you have the skills required for the project;
- in the case of persons to be appointed as members of the Foundation's Board of Trustees, it may be necessary to check your CV as well as how the other requirements for this position are met.

Legal basis:

- **the execution and performance of the contract with you;**
- compliance with **our legal obligations;**
- **Vodafone Foundation's legitimate interest** in verifying that the criteria for your involvement in Vodafone Foundation projects are met.

7.2. Implementation of activities carried out by the Vodafone Foundation – projects, campaigns

Depending on your involvement in Vodafone Foundation projects, we will process your personal data as follows:

- in the case of volunteers or partners who will be involved in projects run by the Vodafone Foundation, your personal data will be processed to allow access to the online platforms on which the project is run and for the development and implementation of the project. Personal data processed for this purpose are contact data, cookie and technology data, login data;
- in the case of donors involved in projects run by the Vodafone Foundation, your personal data will be processed to allow access to the platforms where you will be able to make donations or, as the case may be, to complete donations and to communicate with you in relation to them. Thus, the personal data processed for this purpose are contact data, cookie and technology data, login data;
- if you are a contact person or legal representative of a Vodafone Foundation partner legal entity, we will process your identification data (e.g. name, surname, occupation/position, signature) in case we need to sign a contract with you and you act as a signatory party. We will also process your contact data (e.g. your telephone number and email) if you have been designated to act as our partner's contact person in relation to us and we may use that data to contact you in relation to any issues relating to our business relationship with you (e.g. payment processing, contract processing, etc.).

Based on this information, the Vodafone Foundation may generate aggregate and statistical management reports that do not identify you individually. The Vodafone Foundation may also retrieve this personal data and anonymise it in order to carry out a more in-depth analysis of the activities carried out.

Legal basis:

- **the execution and performance of the contract with you;**
- complying with **our legal obligations** as a non-governmental organisation;
- **Vodafone's legitimate interest** in ensuring the smooth implementation of projects in which you are involved;
- **your consent** to contact you about the work of the Vodafone Foundation and your involvement in our projects.

7.3. Marketing

Communications on events organised by Vodafone Foundation

We would like to use your Contact Details to keep you informed about events and projects run by the Vodafone Foundation team. In this context, we may send you newsletters about our work, events we organise and projects we are about to implement.

We can contact you by:

- **electronic means of communication**, such as e-mail or telephone (calls with human operators), and/or
- **post** (mail or courier services).

Legal basis: we will rely on **your permission** to receive such communications.

Inclusion in promotional materials of activities and projects carried out by the Vodafone Foundation

In order to promote the various events organized by the Vodafone Foundation and to implement the various projects it runs, we may process your image (photo or video) and publish it either online or in physical promotional materials – brochures, banners, etc.

Legal basis: we will rely strictly on **your permission** for your inclusion in such Vodafone Foundation materials and actions.

7.4. Relationship with authorities | Dispute resolution and litigation

We process personal data where it is reasonable to do so to protect against fraud, to defend our rights or property, or to protect the interests of our partners, in the context of potential or existing litigation or disputes in which the Vodafone Foundation may be involved, including any proceedings before any administrative, criminal, arbitral or civil courts or institutions.

As part of these procedures, we may receive or disclose your personal data to third parties (e.g. courts, public authorities, litigants, lawyers) or we may need to disclose your information to comply with our legal obligation to respond to legitimate requests from authorities. Your personal data will only be provided in cases where we believe we have an obligation to do so under the law and following a thorough assessment of all legal requirements.

Legal basis:

- **legal obligation**, where we have an obligation to disclose information, or
- **legitimate interest**, for disclosure of personal data to public authorities in any situation where disclosure is based on a compelling justification and there are no overriding fundamental rights of the data subject (analysis to be carried out on a case-by-case basis). In addition, in the event of disputes or litigation, we rely on **our legitimate interest** in the proper resolution of disputes and litigation and in defending our rights and interests in such proceedings. Depending on the specific procedures applicable, we may also be required by law to disclose information (including personal data) to third parties in the context of those procedures.

7.5. Compliance with specific legal and regulatory requirements

We will also process and disclose your personal data whenever necessary to comply with other regulatory requirements (national or EU) applicable to us.

Legal basis:

- compliance with **legal obligations** or
- **Vodafone Foundation's legitimate interest** to address and manage the relevant legal requirements applicable to us (whenever such legal requirement does not directly require Vodafone Foundation to process personal data, but the achievement of the purpose involves the processing of your personal data).

8. If you are the beneficiary of a campaign run by the Vodafone Foundation

We will use your personal data for the following purposes:

8.1. Eligibility checks

Before your involvement in the project run by Vodafone Foundation we may carry out certain checks to verify whether you are eligible to be a beneficiary of our campaigns, as follows:

- in the case of individual projects, we will be able to check the supporting documents you provide us with, including documents proving your state of health, on the basis of which you apply for Vodafone Foundation support;
- in the case of other projects run by the Vodafone Foundation, we may also process other personal data necessary for your involvement in the project in question – e.g. data on your address, income, etc.

Legal basis:

- **the execution and performance of the contract with you;**
- compliance with **our legal obligations;**
- **Vodafone's legitimate interest** in verifying that the criteria for your involvement in Vodafone Foundation projects are met.

8.2. Implementation of activities carried out by the Vodafone Foundation – projects, campaigns

Depending on your role in Vodafone projects, we will process your personal data as follows:

- in the case of individual projects run by the Vodafone Foundation, we will use your contact details and financial data to run the fundraising campaign;
- in the case of certain campaigns / projects run by the Vodafone Foundation, we may publish some limited personal data about you on online platforms necessary to run the campaign – e.g. on the Letters to Santa Claus Platform we may, subject to your / your guardian's consent, publish your image, name;
- depending on the specifics of the campaign / project run by the Vodafone Foundation, we may make available to our partners your limited personal data necessary for the implementation of the project – e.g. identification data, contact details.

Based on this information, the Vodafone Foundation may also generate aggregate and statistical management reports that do not identify you individually. The Vodafone Foundation may also retrieve this personal data and anonymise it in order to carry out a more in-depth analysis of the activities carried out.

Legal basis:

- **the execution and performance of the contract with you;**
- complying with **our legal obligations** as a non-governmental organisation;
- **Vodafone's legitimate interest** in ensuring the smooth implementation of projects in which you are involved;
- **your consent** to contact you about the work of the Vodafone Foundation and your involvement in our projects.

8.3. Marketing

Communications on events organised by Vodafone Foundation

We would like to use your Contact Details to keep you informed about events and projects run by the Vodafone Foundation team. In this context, we may send you newsletters about our work, events we organise and projects we are about to implement.

We can contact you by:

- **electronic means of communication**, such as e-mail or telephone (calls with human operators), and/or
- **post** (mail or courier services).

Legal basis: we will rely on **your permission** to receive such communications.

In addition, in the event of disputes or litigation, we rely on **our legitimate interest** in the proper resolution of disputes and litigation and in defending our rights and interests in such proceedings. Depending on the specific procedures applicable, we may also be required by law to disclose information (including personal data) to third parties in the context of those procedures.

8.5. Compliance with specific legal and regulatory requirements

We will also process and disclose your personal data whenever necessary to comply with other regulatory requirements (national or EU) applicable to us.

Legal basis:

- compliance with **legal obligations** or
- **Vodafone's legitimate interest** to address and manage the relevant legal requirements applicable to Vodafone (whenever such legal requirement does not directly require Vodafone to process personal data, but the achievement of the purpose involves the processing of your personal data).

9. If you are a candidate / employee of the Vodafone Foundation

We will use your personal data for the following purposes:

9.1. Recruitment activity

If you apply for a position with the Vodafone Foundation, we will process your personal data for the purposes of recruitment and job placement, including notification of future job opportunities, and in the case of successful candidates, for employment purposes.

To the extent provided to us, we will process the following personal data about you: identification data, contact data, data on your professional experience, data on the information provided by you in the recruitment process as well as the results of the assessment process.

Legal basis:

- **processing is necessary for the purpose of entering into the contract with you.**

9.2. Workforce and contract management

If you are an employee of the Vodafone Foundation, we will process your personal data as follows:

- managing and implementing the contractual relationship with you, including implementing an electronic personnel file, managing your benefits, your travel expenses, managing your time, maintaining your time sheets, paying your salary and other related benefits;
- collecting data about the quality and quantity of your performance in order to carry out our work and at the same time to manage your performance;
- fulfilling our legal obligations, such as paying taxes and contributions, maintaining contact with the competent authorities, filing declarations;

Thus, in order to implement the operations described above, we may process the following categories of personal data: contact details, identification details, pay information, leave details, limited information on your health status, qualifications, work history, training details, security information, information on your attendance at work.

Legal basis:

- **the execution and performance of the contract with you;**
- complying with **our legal obligations** as an employer;
- **Vodafone's legitimate interest** in ensuring the smooth implementation of projects in which you are involved and the organisation and conduct of its business;

9.3. Marketing

Inclusion in promotional materials of activities and projects carried out by the Vodafone Foundation

In order to promote the various events organized by the Vodafone Foundation and the implementation of the various projects run by it in which you participate as an employee of the Vodafone Foundation, we may process your image (photo or video) and publish it either online or in physical promotional materials – brochures, banners, etc.

Legal basis: we will rely strictly on **your permission** for your inclusion in such Vodafone Foundation materials and actions.

9.4. Relationship with authorities | Dispute resolution and litigation

We process personal data where it is reasonable to do so to protect against fraud, to defend our rights or property, or to protect the interests of our partners, in the context of potential or existing litigation or disputes in which the Vodafone Foundation may be involved, including any proceedings before any administrative, criminal, arbitral or civil courts or institutions.

As part of these procedures, we may receive or disclose your personal data to third parties (e.g. courts, public authorities, litigants, lawyers) or we may need to disclose your information to comply with our legal obligation to respond to legitimate requests from authorities. Your personal data will only be provided in cases where we believe we have an obligation to do so under the law and after a thorough assessment of all legal requirements.

Legal basis:

- **legal obligation**, where we have an obligation to disclose information, or
- **legitimate interest**, for disclosure of personal data to public authorities in any situation where disclosure is based on a compelling justification and there are no overriding fundamental rights of the data subject (analysis to be carried out on a case-by-case basis). In addition, in the event of disputes or litigation, we rely on **our legitimate interest** in the proper resolution of disputes and litigation and in defending our rights and interests in such proceedings. Depending on the specific procedures applicable, we may also be required by law to disclose information (including personal data) to third parties in the context of those procedures.

9.5. Compliance with specific legal and regulatory requirements

We will also process and disclose your personal data whenever necessary to comply with other regulatory requirements (national or EU) applicable to us.

Legal basis:

- compliance with **legal obligations** or
- **Vodafone's legitimate interest** to address and manage the relevant legal requirements applicable to Vodafone (whenever such legal requirement does not directly require Vodafone to process personal data, but the achievement of the purpose involves the processing of your personal data).

10. How and to whom we disclose your personal data?

We disclose your personal data *to persons authorised* by the Vodafone Foundation to process personal data, i.e. entities that we engage to provide services on our behalf. We have written contracts in place with persons authorised by Vodafone to process personal data whereby they undertake not to take any action in relation to your personal data unless instructed to do so by us. *The authorised persons* will undertake to keep your personal data secure for the entire period indicated by us.

Also, when we are required or entitled we may disclose your personal data to third parties who acting as *independent controllers* (entities that process the data for their own purposes) or, where applicable, entities acting as *associated controllers* with us (in which case we determine with them the purposes and/or means of processing the data).

The categories of recipients of your personal data (processors, independent controllers, associated controllers – as applicable), include:

- **The Vodafone Group companies** that support us in running our business;
- **Partners or agents involved in delivering the products and services** we need to run our business and implement the projects you are involved in;
- **Companies contracted by us** for events/marketing initiatives necessary to promote the work of the Vodafone Foundation;
- **Public and regulatory authorities, governmental bodies courts** – if necessary including if required by law or, where appropriate, **a third party entity or organization** – where such disclosure is necessary to comply with any applicable legal requirements, or other legal or regulatory requirements.

In some situations we have a legal obligation to disclose your information (for example, under a court order or upon the request of a regulatory body, including a data protection authority). We may also share information with other regulatory bodies to fulfil their powers or our objectives. In any of these situations, we will check that we have a legal basis for disclosing personal data;

- **Third party consultants** (e.g. external lawyers, auditors, experts) where we involve them in litigation or disputes relevant to us or other activities requiring their professional expertise;
- **Third party organizations involved in providing services related to cookies and similar technologies**, as detailed in our Cookie Usage Policy, available here: <https://fundatia-vodafone.ro/politica-de-utilizare-a-cookie-urilor/>

11. Keeping and storing your personal data

The Vodafone Foundation has implemented policies and rules on the retention of personal data that comply with the data retention principles set out in the Data Protection Act. The retention periods are reviewed periodically.

In general, we will retain your personal data (1) for the duration of the contract with us or the duration of the project in which you are involved, plus a reasonable period (depending on the circumstances), or (2) for the duration required by law or determined by a public authority under the terms of the law, or (3) in the event of disputes or litigation, until their closure, plus a reasonable period (depending on the circumstances). After the expiry of this period, personal data may be irreversibly destroyed, deleted or anonymised (as appropriate).

If you would like detailed information on Vodafone's data retention rules, you can contact us through the communication channels mentioned in paragraph 4 of the Privacy Policy.

12. International data transfers

In general, we keep your personal data in our location in Romania.

The Vodafone Foundation may need to transfer your data to other Vodafone Group companies or external service providers in countries within the European Economic Area (EEA) as well as outside the EEA. Transfer outside the EEA may occur if our servers (i.e. the servers on which we store the data) or our suppliers and service providers are based outside the EEA or if you use Vodafone services and products while visiting countries outside the EEA.

If the Vodafone Foundation transfers your personal data to a country outside the EEA, we will ensure that your data is adequately protected. As a rule, we will ensure that there is a proper legal agreement on data transfer in accordance with the standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission (https://ec.europa.eu/info/law/law-topic/data-protection/data-transfers-outside-eu/model-contracts-transfer-personal-data-third-countries_en). In addition, if it is considered that the country in question does not have laws that are equivalent to EU data protection standards, the Vodafone Foundation will require the third party to enter into a legal agreement reflecting these standards. If the transfer will not be based on such an agreement, we will ensure that the transfer is always based on another mechanism provided by law to ensure the protection of your personal data.

If personal data is transferred to countries outside the EEA, we will attach a list of recipient countries to this Privacy Policy. The Vodafone Foundation may periodically update this list whenever there are changes in the way personal data is transferred.

14. Your rights

The right to rectification of personal data
